



# Acorn Class, Term 3 Topic – Africa

## Enquiry Question – Who Made These Footprints?



By the end of the half term the children will have...

- Ordered the story of Handa's Surprise.
  - Spoken about what a surprise is, when we get surprised and how it feels to be surprised.
  - Looked at where lions come from and what habitat they need to survive.
  - Learnt new language, linked to our topic.
  - Explored African music
  - Looked at and created a piece of African silhouette art
- What do animals eat and where do they live? Science (Living things and their habitats)
- Spoken about Africa and its similarities and differences between England and Stonegate.
  - Explored a World Map and Globe and discussed what they are.
  - Spoken about Kenya, the people that live there and the language they speak.
  - Spoken about the different animals found in Africa, what they look like and what they eat.
  - Spoken about the different habitats the African animals live in.
  - Spoken about Mount Kenya, Nairobi, Lake Victoria and the River Nile and locate them on a map.
  - Learnt how to program a Bee Bot to make it move around a map.
  - Spoken about the difference between Fiction and Non-Fiction books and the features of a Non-Fiction book.
  - Spoken about how to use the internet to search for information.
  - Described African animals and written about them.
  - Described different African habitats and written about them.
  - Re-capped on the names of the 4 seasons.
  - Spoken about Winter and when it is.
  - Spoken about what happens in Winter and what the signs of Winter are.
  - Spoken about how Winter is different to Autumn, Spring and Summer.
  - Taken part in a Winter Walk; hunting for the signs of Winter.
  - Drawn the signs of Winter and written about them.
  - Spoken about Pancake Day, why it is called Shrove Tuesday, Lent and what it is.
  - Completed a weekly yoga lesson with Mrs Hazeldine
